1. Q: Will power lines be moved or shut off for crane work at the project site?
A: Lewis County Public Utility District No. 1 (PUD) will re-route power onto temporary poles along the traffic detour route. PUD will be responsible for moving power lines, however, the Contractor may need to work simultaneously with PUD crews after clearing trees. Coordination between the Contractor and PUD will be further discussed at the project's preconstruction meeting.
